



DAY 7 · FRIDAY: HVAR – BOL – SPLIT

On Friday you can expect busy day. After breakfast we sail for Bol. Bol has the most famous beach in Croatia called Zlatni Rat (Golden Horn).

After morning swim you will have opportunity to join us on tour of awarded winery Jako Vino, renowned wine producer dating back to 1903. Their cellars were renovated in autumn 2009 and you can come here to taste their wines, including white Pošip, red Sv. Vid and rose Opol, as well as tasteful canapé bites made of olives, anchovies and cheese and also purchase bottles to bring home.

After lunch we will continue towards Split. In early afternoon we arrive back where we started – Split. Aspalathos was the name of the ancient Greek settlement from which modern Split grew. It later became Spalatum under the Romans but it remained small until Emperor Diocletian built his luxurious palace there around 300 AD. After his death, expelled Roman emperors made Diocletian's Palace their home away from home but when Avars and Slavs conquered Salona (now Solin) in 614 AD its displaced citizens fled to Diocletian's Palace for shelter and a new town was born. The new population set about altering the palace to suit their own housing needs, which is what gives Split sightseeing its special flavour.

After grand tour of Diocletian's Palace and Split Old Town you will arrive back on the boat in plenty time to get ready for Capitan's dinner and Gala evening with live entertainment.
